From ancient days, Christian piety has held that wherever the Most Holy Eucharist is reserved, angels are present who constantly adore Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. Christian art, summarizing popular piety, has often shown representations of angels surrounding the monstrances with their faces covered by their wings, because they consider themselves unworthy to be in His presence. So great is His majesty! Let us ask them to teach us to treat Jesus, really present in the tabernacle, with greater love and, at the same time, to show Him the greatest possible reverence.
